Table

- 1 4 x 8-foot sheet 1/2" birch plywood, ripped into 3" strips
- 1 4 x 8-foot sheet 1/2" plywood
- 4 8" lengths of 2 x 2
- 2 8-foot lengths 1/4" x 1 1/4" wood molding
- 4 T nuts, 1/4"
- 20 carriage bolts, 1/4" x 2"
- 20 washers, 1/4"
- 16 lock nuts, 1/4"
- 4 wing nuts, 1/4"
- Carpenter's glue

Atlas True-Track or Bachmann E-Z Track

- 11 9" straights
- 20 18" radius curves
- 2 3" straights
- 2 left-hand switches
- 2 right-hand switches

Kato track

- 2 6 7/8" straights (B)
 - 6 9 3/4" radius curves (C)
 - 2 Bumper (E)
 - 24 21 1/2" right curve (F)
 - 2 left turnout (J)
 - 2 right turnout (K)
 - 1 2 3/8" left filler (L)
 - 2 2 3/8" right filler (M)
 - 1 4 1/2" straight (N)
 - 4 short curve (O)

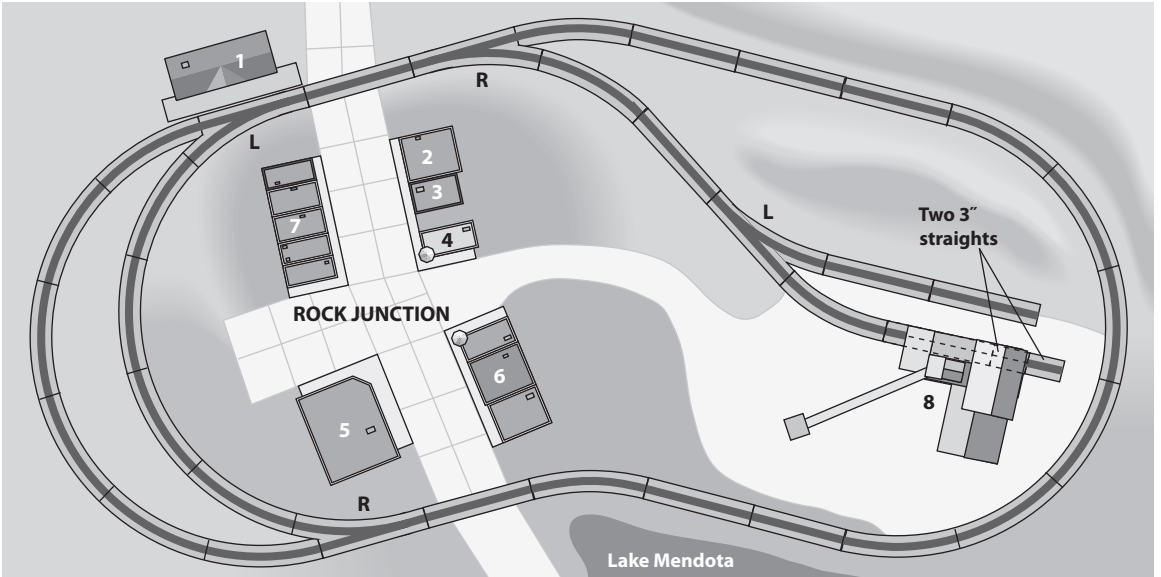

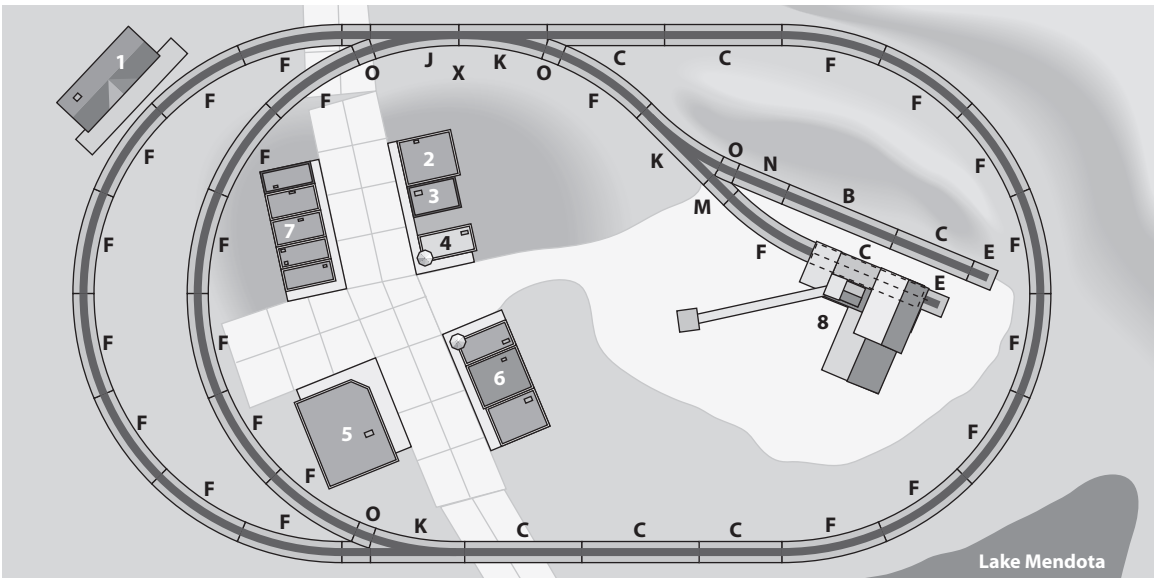


Atlas True-Track or Bachmann E-Z Track
